- Being mobile and networked increase our connection to places

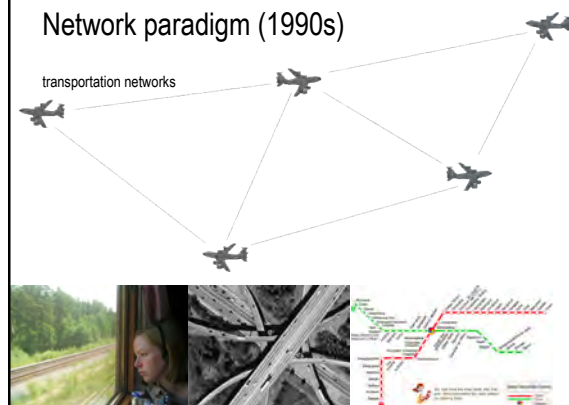
